## Community Education Services

### DWI Intervention Course

This class provides a State Certified Course of alcohol education to people who have two or more DWI offenses. Participants must attend all 15 sessions to receive required state certificate.

### Adult Choices & Consequences Class

This class is to educate the community about the disease concept of alcohol and drug abuse. Participants must attend all required sessions to receive a certificate for 6 or 8 hour course.

### Minor In Possession of Alcohol Class

This class is to educate the youth on the dangers of underage drinking. The class will be held in two sessions of 3 ½ hours each for a total of 7 hours.

### Substance Abuse Subtle Screening Inventory

The SASSI evaluation serves to identify risk of substance abuse disorder and is administered to those as required by the criminal justice system.

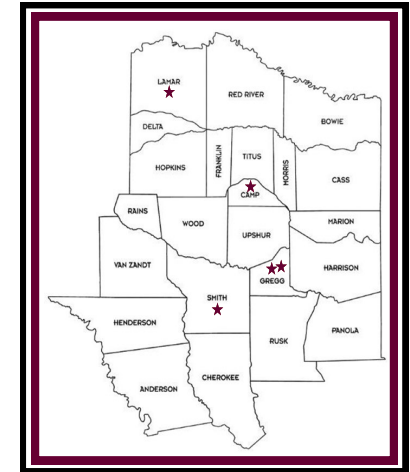

## Prevention Services

### Youth Prevention

The **Youth Prevention Universal (YPU)** and **Youth Prevention Indicated (YPI)** programs utilize the evidence-based curriculum Positive Action facilitated by a certified instructor in its fidelity for students in 3rd thru 12th grades. The eight sessions contain a variety of interactive lessons which address the underlying causes of substance abuse and provide students with the life skills needed to make healthy choices while reinforcing the philosophy that you feel good about yourself when you do positive actions.

### Prevention Resource Center

The **Prevention Resource Center (PRC)** focuses on regional substance abuse and related factors, data collection and distribution, and is a training liaison in substance abuse prevention for the region. Avenues utilized to disseminate data collected are through our web site at [www.prcfour.org](http://www.prcfour.org) and Region 4 PRC social media pages where we post state and regional data trends, training opportunities, and events. PRC4 also coordinates continuing education in Prevention Specialists and other professionals seeking education in the field of Behavioral Health.

The **PRC4 Tobacco Education Specialist** conducts voluntary tobacco retailer compliance checks, provides education on current tobacco laws, and confirms adherence to Texas state tobacco laws.

## Support and Recovery Services

### Outreach, Screening, Assessment and Referral

Individuals seeking substance use disorder treatment are first screened by **Licensed Chemical Dependency Counselors (LCDC)**. Our LCDCs, sub-contracted through Andrews Center LMHA, provide one-on-one, confidential and coordinated access to a continuum of substance use disorder providers.

### ETCADA Burgess Recovery Center

The ETCADA Burgess Recovery Center's **Certified Peer Recovery Support Specialists** provide a wide range of recovery support services that encourage, motivate, and assist individuals and their families .

### Recovery Rocks Women's Group

A confidential **peer support group for women** led by a Certified Peer Recovery Coach providing support and encouragement for those in recovery.

### The Men's Group

A confidential **peer support group for men** led by a Certified Peer Recovery Coach providing support and encouragement for those in recovery.

### Winners Circle "Let it begin with me"

A confidential **peer support group for recovering ex-offenders** led by a Certified Re-Entry Peer Specialist that offers a non-judgmental support and encouragement for those in recovery.

## D.O.R.S. Youth Transition Center Developing Opportunities Realizing Success

**D.O.R.S. Youth Transition Center's** services empower at-risk and homeless young people ages 15 to 25 years old to move past obstacles and on to success.

### Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) Foster Program Grant

The TANF Foster Program Grant is designed to help young people age 16 to 25 years old that have ever been in foster care achieve self-efficiency with employment.

### Job Ready!

The Job Ready! Program combines classes and an internship with a local employer to help participants learn the skills and traits of a valuable employee.

### Transitional Housing

The Transitional Housing Program helps homeless young people actively work on their Transition Plan out of poverty along side a case coordinator.

### Operation Turnaround

Operation Turnaround participants complete classes, earn community service hours, and learn how to get out of the criminal justice system.

### Healthy Inside & Out

Healthy Inside & Out participants learn how to improve their health with counseling, non-narcotic prescription assistance, cooking classes, and self-defense training.
